In The Classroom

1. The school will provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating students to meet the State's academic achievement standards.
2. The school will provide parents with frequent reports on their student's progress. Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:

3. The school will provide parents reasonable access to staff throughout the school year.
4. The school will hold parent--teacher conferences during which the teacher and parents can discuss topics that relate to the individual student's achievement.
5. The school will provide a structured and safe learning environment for all students attending Sanchez Charter School.

At Home

1. Parents will support our children's learning in the following ways:
 - *Monitoring attendance*
 - *Making sure that homework is completed*
 - *Staying informed about my child's education and communicating with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school either received by my child or by mail and responding, appropriately*
2. Parents should be supportive of the school/teachers in their efforts to provide the best education possible for their child.
3. Parents should review the rules and guidelines of Sanchez Charter School with their children.
4. Parents should be available to encourage, praise, advise, and supervise their children.
5. Parents should monitor your child's understanding of concepts and skills.

Students

1. The student will share the responsibility to improve my academic achievement. Specifically, I will:
 - *Complete homework daily, including outside reading, and ask for help when needed*
 - *Give my parents (and/or guardian) all notices and information received by me from my school every day*
 - *Support and uphold school policies and procedures*
 - *I will respect teachers, staff, other students, and school property*
2. The student will exercise self-control while in the learning environment. The student is also responsible for remaining quiet and on task during class time so as not to disrupt the learning of other students.
3. The student is responsible for communicating any concerns to the teacher and/or the campus administrators.
4. The student is responsible for bringing to class all necessary materials (book, paper, pen, pencil, calculator, etc.).
5. The students will respect the rights of all who are involved in the educational process, thus ensuring their own rights as students and as people.
